## Biography

李焯然教授畢業於香港大學中文系，一級榮譽文學士、哲學碩士，其後獲英聯邦獎學金赴澳洲國立大學深造，獲哲學博士學位。目前任教于新加坡國立大學中文系，曾擔任新嘉坡國立大學文學院助理院長、漢學研究中心主任、中文系系主任等職，現為文學暨社會科學院中國研究副修課程主任，新加坡國立大學/北京大學雙學位（漢語）課程主任。

專門研究中國思想、文化、明代史、東亞儒學、華人宗教與民俗。出版專著有《明史散論》、《明成祖史論》、《儒學傳統與思想變遷》、《道教簡述》、《丘濬評傳》等，並為新加坡

國立大學《漢學論叢》、北京《國際中國文化研究文庫》、歐洲 Ming Qing Studies 、日本 Journal of Cultural Interactions in East Asia 等叢書及學報擔任編輯。李教授同時為中國武漢大學、南京大學、湖北大學客座教授。學術工作以外，李教授亦受委擔任新加坡總統宗教和諧理事會理事、新加坡媒體管理局華文節目諮詢委員會主席、新加坡族譜學會副會長。

Professor Lee Cheuk Yin graduated from the University of Hong Kong (B.A. 1st Class Honours; M. Phil.) and received his doctorate from the Australian National University. A former Swire Scholar and Commonwealth Scholar, his research interests include Chinese intellectual history, Chinese culture, East-Asian Confucianism, and Chinese beliefs and customs. He has served as Sub-Dean of the Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences, Director of the Centre for Research in Chinese Studies and Head of the Department of Chinese Studies, at the National University of Singapore, and is currently Academic Director of the Minor in China Studies Programme at the Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences and the NUS-PKU Double MA Degree (Chinese Language) Programme. Besides academic duties, Professor Lee is concurrently Council Member of the Presidential Council for Religious Harmony of the Singapore Government, Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Chinese Programmes of the Media Development Authority of Singapore, and Vice President of the Singapore Genealogy Society.
